ISLAND AIR RELEASES ON-TIME PERFORMANCE FOR FOURTH QUARTER AND FOR NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER

HONOLULU — Island Air announced that for the fourth quarter of 2015, 85.1 percent of Island Air's flights arrived on time. Month by month on-time performance during the quarter was: October — 86.2%, November — 79.7% and December — 89.3%. (As is the case with major airlines that report their on-time information to the U.S. Department of Transportation, a flight is counted as "on time" if it arrives within 14 minutes of its scheduled arrival time.)*

In addition, for the fourth quarter of 2015, the airline completed 98.7% of all scheduled flights (27 cancellations out of 2,123 flights). Month by month completion rates were: October – 99% flight completion rate (7 cancelled flights out of 717), November – 97.3% (19 cancellations out of 695 flights) and in December – 99.9% (only 1 cancellation out of 720 flights).

"While a scheduled, but lengthy, heavy maintenance event for one of our aircraft caused some challenges in November, our team ended the year with an incredibly strong record in on-time-performance, and more importantly, we had a near-perfect record in successfully completing 720 scheduled flights for the month of December," said Island Air CEO Dave Pflieger. "This impressive performance is great news for our airline and our customers and these solid results show how well our team is doing at Island Air and how we're doing compared to other airlines here and overseas."

Island Air began announcing its operational performance in September. The airline plans to continue releasing flight performance data on a monthly and quarterly basis, so that current and potential customers can see for themselves how the airline is performing as the carrier continues to improve and position itself for a strong future as Hawai'i's affordable alternative interisland airline.
