ISLAND AIR TO WAIVE CHANGE FEES DURING HURRICANES MADELINE AND LESTER

HONOLULU — Island Air will waive reservation change fees and differences in fares for customers needing to change their travel plans due to Hurricanes Madeline and Lester.

Effective immediately, customers ticketed for travel on Island Air from August 31, 2016 through September 3, 2016 will be permitted to change their reservations without charge to ticketed flights through September 10, 2016.

Changes must be made prior to the original departure date and ticketed on or before September 3, 2016.

Changes must be made by Island Air personnel through the reservations department, or at the airport. Normal refund rules will apply.
